Development of a purpose-built 130,000 sq ft office/production facility within a 13 acre site for an international wholesale bakery company. Works included the construction of a base-build shell (design and build) and highly serviced fit-out (Construction Management route) including installation of 6 automated production lines for premium bakery goods.





Key challenges/features

- Construction completed on-schedule despite initial six month delay to project start date and funding approval
- / Ceiling required raising half way through construction, with no disruption to schedule or installed services and equipment
- / Most technologically advanced bakery in Europe
- Fast-track design/planning/construction periods to meet required date for commencing production to meet business case (two year period from start to finish)
- Procurement and management of over 100 contractors within a 13-acre construction site
- Structured approach to management/coordination of various work-streams covering the complete project scope
- Use of Construction Management procurement route to meet the programme requirement and allow integration of Client appointed production equipment contractors
